Special Olympics Canada Winter Games

CALGARY 2024





February 27 - March 2, 2024

Calgary is ready to welcome the nation for the **Special Olympics Canada Winter Games Calgary 2024**. Over 4,000 visitors, including athletes, coaches, officials, and mission staff, along with their families and friends, will gather in Canada's winter sport capital.

Celebrations officially commence February 27, with the Law Enforcement Torch Run (LETR), VIP Reception, and the Opening Ceremony presented by the Calgary Flames Foundation. The Games wrap up March 2 with a community celebration presented by Safeway at Olympic Plaza in the morning, then the Closing Ceremony that evening, followed by the popular athletes' dance. The days between are packed with the eight sporting competitions and various activities and events.

What are the Special Olympics?

Did you know...

- ▶ The Special Olympics began as a result of a Canadian researcher, Dr. Frank Hayden, a sport scientist at the University of Toronto. His research challenged the mindset of the day and proved that it was not a person's disability that prevented them from participating in sports, it was simply the lack of opportunity.
- Dr. Hayden's research and proposal for a National sport competition and caught the attention of Eunice Kennedy Shriver. As a result, the first Special Olympics competition was held in 1968 in Chicago.
- ▶ Canada was represented by a group of 12 students and a teacher from the Beverley School, as well as Toronto Maple Leafs captain George Armstrong, serving as Honorary Team Captain.

Renfrew is excited about the games!

Our teachers and staff have lots of activities planned to celebrate the Special Olympics Canada Winter Games - both in the classrooms and in the gym. We will learn about the sports like Alpine Skiing, Curling, Floor Hockey, Snowshoeing and more!

Who knows, maybe some of our Renfrew students will be inspired to become future Special Olympians themselves!


