Renfrew Educational Services Celebrates 50 Years!

For 50 years, Renfrew Educational Services has continued to develop and meet the needs of families. You may not be aware that Renfrew grew from a one-room classroom to our current four schools, community services and our Assessment and Therapy Services department.

Renfrew is a not-for-profit registered charity operating as an independent school, and as such, we are required to raise all funds for capital projects. Projects include purchasing and maintaining our fleet of buses, building our schools, and making school improvements and expansions. Generous support from corporate Calgary, individual donors, and the Renfrew Board of Directors, along with staff and families, makes a tremendous impact on the success of our fundraising endeavours!





Our Programs & Services

We know as parents you are aware of the school programs that we offer but there are many other programs and services that Renfrew provides. As parents of Renfrew, you are ambassadors for new families and for potential supporters/donors to Renfrew. We are very proud of the programs and services we offer to many families throughout the city of Calgary and surrounding areas.

Our school sites have been thoughtfully placed throughout the city of Calgary. Each of our sites provides a **Preschool Program** and at the Janice McTighe and Thomas W. Buchanan Centres, you will also find our **Elementary and Junior High Program** for students with disabilities.

At each of our sites a comprehensive program for children with Autism is offered which includes an onsite and home component. This program is called **Specialized Services Program (SSP)** and spaces are limited. If this is of interest to you, please speak to the manager at your child's site. We also offer **Integrated Services for Children with Motor Disabilities (ISMD)** a specialized program for children with motor disabilities such as Cerebral Palsy which has a strong focus on motor development. This program can be found at the Janice McTighe and the Thomas W. Buchanan again if this is of interest to you, please speak to the manager at your site. Both these programs are offered to children in our pre-school program.

Our **Community Services Department** continues to provide services to students attending Calgary Catholic School District, Foothills School Division, and Golden Hills School District along with various Independent Schools. Our **Assessment and Therapy Services Department** continues to grow as we provide services such as assessments, intervention, counselling, Low Incidence, and Play therapy city wide and to surrounding areas such as Airdrie, Okotoks, Chestermere, Canmore. Renfrew is also providing programs and services to Tsuut'ina, and Stoney Nakoda First Nations.

Our services also extend after hours and include the following programs.

- Our Stepping Out on Saturdays (SOS) Respite Program is a unique service which provides a Saturday program for children with disabilities from 5 to 12 years of age.
- Our Augmentative or Alternative Communication (AAC) Everywhere program is a Saturday program offering various social outings Which provides opportunities for children using devices to communicate with other peers – parent/guardian participation is required.

This year we are providing services to over 50 contracts resulting in programs and services for more than 10,000 children/students in Calgary, and surrounding areas.

Ongoing registration for children with disabilities continues for children who are presently registered with Renfrew. If you have not confirmed your child will be returning next September, please contact the manager at your child's site.

Are you a parent or caregiver of a child in early intervention programming?
