We have experienced many busing changes over the last month, but we feel overall our bus service has settled into a regular routine. We are very fortunate to have an outstanding transportation system with a fleet of 48 buses and the most amazing bus drivers! Helping Kids Soar Charity Gala March 13th, 2025 – "Building our Future"

We are so excited to hold our 26th gala event – from small beginnings raising \$15,000.00 dollars year one to \$345,000.00 this past March. We are presently working on our sponsorship material and will be asking our families for support in purchasing auction items and sponsorships.

Did you know that Renfrew is a not-for-profit organization, and we rely on fundraising for many of our special projects. We do not receive any government funding for any capital expenses so all of our specialty rooms such as our Mind and Movement Rooms, Greenhouses, Multi-Sensory Rooms along with Specialized Equipment, Assistive Technology, and we cannot forget our Buses,

and school buildings are all paid for by individuals like you. We are grateful for the support we receive which allows

us to provide exceptional spaces and materials for your children.

To date we have raised just over 17 million dollars over halfway to the project goal of 30 million. This year's gala funds will continue to support the Legacy School in Bearspaw. This is a very exciting project as we build a school that will offer chidlren (preschool to grade 12) with disabilities an exceptional program in a purposeful designed school.

Did You Know...

Renfrew offers many different types of services to children and families within Renfrew as well as within the community.

- We offer our Preschool Programs at our four school sites. In our preschool we serve close to 400 children. We also offer 150 spaces to students in our Elementary Education and Jr. High Program. The Elementary/Jr. High programs operate out of the Janice McTighe and Thomas W. Buchanan Centres.
- Our specialized programs/services include Children with Motor Disabilities, Autism Spectrum Disorders, Wellness Empowerment Program, and Stoney Nakoda and Tsuut'ina Nations.
- Our Community Services department continues to provide services to students attending various community and Independent Schools.
- Our Assessment and Therapy
 Services department offers work in the community completing assessments and intervention.


