Stepping Out on Saturdays Respite Program

Renfrew Educational Services offers a Saturday respite program for children with disabilities between the age of 5-12 years. The **Stepping Out on Saturdays (SOS) Program** operates out of the Janice McTighe and Thomas W. Buchanan Centres on select Saturdays from 9:30am to 2:30pm.

The program is run by trained Renfrew staff with experience working with children with disabilities. Each Saturday offers a variety of play-centred activities, gross motor activities, and small group activities.

Program Fees

The cost of the program is \$150.00 per session. If you have an FSCD contract, you may be eligible for some funding coverage. Contact your FSCD worker to determine if coverage is available. (FSCD funding typically covers \$100.00/session - parents are responsible for the remainder. Fees are set annually and are subject to change.)


