#### **William Watson Lodge**

William Watson Lodge is nestled in Peter Lougheed Provincial Park, on the east side of Lower Kananaskis Lake. Built and maintained by the Alberta Government, the Lodge was opened in September 1981 by Premier Peter Lougheed and his wife Jeanne, who is credited with the idea of creating a facility where Albertans with disabilities could stay and enjoy the outdoors at a reasonable cost. While disabled Albertans have priority, if space is available, Alberta Seniors are welcome. The main lodge and the first four cabins were opened in 1981. Additional cabins were built in 1985 and opened for guests in 1986.

The facility provides year-round accommodation in 22 fully accessible units, to which clients bring their own food and bedding. There are also 13 fully serviced RV sites and a comfort camping unit (open from the May long weekend to Thanksgiving), a playground, picnic sites and 20 kilometres of wheelchair-accessible trails.

#### **Explore Your Freedom to Read with Page**


