Renfrew Educational Services Celebrates 52!

For 52 years, Renfrew Educational Services has continued to grow and adapt to meet the needs of families. What began as a one-room classroom has expanded into four schools, a robust **Community Services** department, and a comprehensive **Assessment and Therapy Services** department.

Renfrew is a **not-for-profit registered charity** operating as an independent school. As such, we must raise all funds required for capital projects, including:

- ▶ Building and expanding our schools
- ▶ Purchasing and maintaining our bus fleet
- ▶ Ongoing school improvements

The generous support of corporate partners, individual donors, families, staff, and the Renfrew Board of Directors plays a critical role in our success. We are deeply grateful for this continued commitment.

Our Programs & Services

While many parents are familiar with our school programs, Renfrew offers a wide range of additional services across Calgary and surrounding areas. As parents, you are important ambassadors for new families and potential supporters, and we are proud of the impact our programs make.

Our school sites are thoughtfully located throughout Calgary. Each site offers a **Preschool Program**, and both the *Janice McTighe Centre* and the *Thomas W. Buchanan Centre* also provide **Elementary and Junior High programs for students with disabilities**.

Specialized Programs:

- ▶ **Specialized Services Program (SSP):**
A comprehensive program for children with Autism, including both onsite and home-based components. Spaces are limited.
- ▶ **Integrated Services for Motor Disabilities (ISMD):**
Designed for children with motor disabilities such as Cerebral Palsy, with a strong focus on motor development.

Both programs are available within our preschool programs. If you are interested, please speak with the manager at your child's site.

Community Services & Therapy Programs

Our **Community Services Department** supports students in Foothills School Division, Golden Hills School Division, and various Independent Schools.

Our **Assessment and Therapy Services Department** continues to expand, offering:

- ▶ Assessments
- ▶ Intervention services
- ▶ Counselling
- ▶ Low-incidence services
- ▶ Play therapy

These services are provided across Calgary and surrounding communities, including **Airdrie, Okotoks, Chestermere, and Canmore**, as well as **Tsuut'ina and Stoney Nakoda First Nations**.

We also offer after-hours programming through our **Stepping Out on Saturdays (SOS) Respite Program**, which provides a Saturday program for children with disabilities aged 5–12.

This year alone, Renfrew is delivering services through **over 50 contracts**, supporting programs and services for **more than 10,000 children and students**.

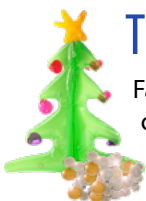

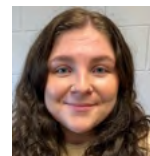

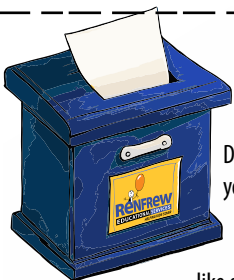

At Renfrew Educational Services, we believe every child deserves the chance to reach their full potential.
