Key Responsibilities:

- Work in collaboration with the team (including but not limited to the teacher and therapists) to plan and supporting programming for children with behavioural challenges, developmental disabilities or special needs.
- Develop strategies and assist children/students in daily routines, language development, fine and gross motor activities, and daily living skills.
- Collaborate with teacher and team with planning and/or modifying the curriculum/daily plan to meet child's needs and address goals.
- Collaborate with team members to develop strategies, programming, and materials
- Work, coach, and support team members of child/student.
- Travel is required.

Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's degree in related field required, or an equivalent combination of education and experience, may be considered.
- At least 1 year practice experience
- At least 1-year experience working with children in an education environment.
- Ability to work with children who may be physically or emotionally demanding
- Understanding of and/or work experience with Indigenous Peoples and First Nations communities.
- Priority will be given Indigenous applicants or those who have experience working on a nation
- A reliable vehicle, auto insurance with a minimum \$2,000,000.00 liability and driver's license is required. (Kilometer expense will be covered for business travel.)
