Key Responsibilities:

- Implement activities, strategies and schedules to address IPP goals.
- Organize and prepare daily plans for children/student utilizing visual schedules, special seating, accessing and modifying learning materials, classroom equipment and activities to meet the needs of the child/student.
- Focus on relationship building, to support the implementation of sensory-based strategies.
- Assist children/student in play activities.
- Documentation of child/student's progress.
- Assist with classroom maintenance.
- Support children with self care skills (i.e., toilet/diaper, feeding, etc.).
- Adapt to changing program needs by providing classroom coverage with a wide range of children/student as needed.

Qualifications:

- A minimum grade twelve diploma. Post-secondary education in a related field (2 year program minimum) or equivalent work experience.
- Experience working with children with special needs is preferred.
- Must be able to meet the physical demands of the position.
- Understanding of and/or work experience with Indigenous Peoples and First Nations communities.
- Those with experiences working on a nation is an asset.
- A reliable vehicle, auto insurance with a minimum \$2,000,000.00 liability and driver's license is required.
